THERE ARE 40,439 DEATHS IN TOTAL AND 38,619 NEW CASES OF COVID-19 CONTAMINATION IN 24H-------

This Sunday, November 8, 2020, there are 40,439 deaths in total and 38,619 new cases of contamination in 24 hours.

In France, the latest assessment provided by the health authorities concerning the COVID-19 pandemic, reports at least 1,787,324 confirmed cases (+38,619) and 40,169 deaths in total. This Sunday, November 8, there are 270 deaths in total. The number of EHPAD and EMS deaths shows a total of 12,509 deaths. The total number of deaths in hospitals is 27,930 (+270 in 24 hours). France currently has 30,243 (+822) people hospitalized, including 4,539 (+118) serious cases in intensive care. This figure corresponds to the highest level recorded during the first wave in France, at the end of March and the beginning of April. According to data from Public Health France, 99 departments are currently in a highly vulnerable situation:
