THE MINISTER OF INTERIOR ASKS FOR THE DISMISSAL OF THE THREE POLICEMEN ------The Minister of the Interior, Gerald Darmanin, guest of the 8:00 p.m. of France 2, announced that he would ask for "the dismissal" of the police, "as soon as the facts are established by justice". He accused them of having "soiled the uniform of the Republic". In a rare public statement, the Paris prosecutor Remy Heitz wanted the IGPN, seized of the file, to investigate "as quickly as possible". "This is an extremely important matter for me and which I have been following personally since Saturday," he told AFP. Several relatives of the President of the Republic expressed their indignation on Twitter. And this Friday morning the Elysee said that Emmanuel Macron was "very shocked" by the video. The President received Gerald Darmanin on Thursday before he went to France 2 at 8 p.m. and asked him to pronounce very clear sanctions against the police.
